1st Month (1-4 Weeks)
 Did you know that a developing baby's heart begins to beat at just 18 days? Isn't that amazing? Muscles are forming, and arms, legs, eyes, and ears have begun to show.

2nd Month (5-8 Weeks)
 By six weeks the jaw forms, including teeth and taste buds. The baby begins to swallow amniotic fluid, and some have been observed hiccupping. The kidneys begin to function. Fingers and toes are developing. At seven weeks a baby's chest and abdomen are fully formed.

RCIA 2019-2020 Registration


